A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Community of Zion,

It's not often that I get feedback that someone actually listened to my sermon or the announcements.

Recently, I mentioned that in some ways Zion is three different congregations because we have three different worship services. While some people go to the different worship times, others pretty much go to the same service each week. Which results in people from the 4 pm service not knowing people who go to the 8 am service who don't know people who go to the 10:15 am service.

It was intended to get everyone to go to the church picnic so they would get to know more people who are part of this community. Can you imagine what it might be like if we had everyone at the church picnic worship service.

What was not intended was this: the week after I said that, there were some people who normally worship at the 8 am service who came to the Saturday service and people who normally attend the Saturday service came to a Sunday service. They said they did it because they realized that it was an opportunity to meet and worship with others.

Like the original announcement, this letter is to invite you to come to the worship service at the church picnic (10:30 am on June 9th) and then stay for the picnic. We meet Sundays at 6:00PM and Wednesdays at 10:00AM. Check the weekly emails for updates.


Are you a Thrivent Member?


Scholarship News... It is with great pleasure that the Scholarship Committee announces our scholarship recipients for the 2024 school year.
