A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Community of Zion,

As you may guess, because of timing, I'm writing this Easter letter in the middle of Lent. You are probably reading this in the middle of Lent. I'm tempted to say "Don't skip ahead". Experience Lent before you jump to Easter. We do know that. We know that the mountain top is that much more meaningful when we've been in the valley. But I think that does a disservice to Lent. It makes Lent a low to Easter's high. It makes Lent sad or maudlin compared to Easter's joy.

So maybe this is more about "being" in Lent, experiencing Lent. We are thinking about and planning for Easter Sunday. We want to make Easter an experience of the joy of God's goodness. Yet we still are in Lent a time of learning, a time of repentance, a time of reflection.
