A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

I've been thinking a lot about communion lately. Partly, because we recently had First Communion Classes. Partly, because we've been trying to find a way to distribute communion that works best for all the people who come to worship. Partly, because someone told me recently that they like how I tell people that everyone is welcome, but if people prefer not to come up for communion that is fine, too.

I've always love word play with the word communion. The words that come out of it and words that it reminds me of......like community and unity.

Mostly though, I like reminding people that communion is "for you". In the Small Catechism, Martin Luther writes "... a person who has faith in these words, 'given for you' and 'shed for you for the forgiveness of sins' is really worthy and well prepared [for communion]. It what I wanted to make sure the First Communion Class knew (it was the final exam.)

It's what I want you to know as you come forward to eat the bread and drink the wine and hear the words "given and shed for you"

You are always welcome at the table.

A Message from the Council President

Special Congregational Meeting Sunday June 2, 2024 Immediately Following the 10:15am Service

Dear Zion Members:

On Tuesday evening on April 23, 2024, the Church Council voted to hold a Special Congregational Meeting on Sunday June 2, 2024 immediately following the 10:15am service. This article, together with the email that was sent out last week serve as the required 10-day notice of the special meeting. The meeting will focus on the following three issues:

- 1. Vote on a paving contract for parking lot and funding.
- 2. Vote on a landscaping contract for the front of the church and funding.
- 3. Call to form a Constitution and Bylaws Committee to update both.

The largest item on the agenda is the paving contract for the parking lot and the way to pay for it. The Council will be requesting the congregation to approve the paving contract and the contract to line the parking lot. The total cost is approximately \$115,000. There currently is \$70,669 in the parking lot fund. The remaining balance of \$44,331 would be funded by the rainy day fund which currently has a balance of \$106,437. The parking lot would be paved either in late June or July.

The landscaping details are currently being finalized, but the initial quote is for approximately \$7,000. The work would entail edging the front flower beds, remove the mulch, put down a weed barrier and top with river stone. It would also include some plantings. A more detail explanation will be provided over the next several weeks. The motion would be to use the bottle and can fund of approximately \$5,000 for this project and fund the remaining amount from the rainy day fund.

The third item is to form a Constitution and Bylaws committee to make amendments to both documents and request volunteers to serve on the committee.

Additional information will be provided for all three of these agenda items over the next several weeks.

A Peek into Zion Nursery School




